

2017 NECLAS PRIZE SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The New England Council of Latin American Studies (NECLAS) invites submissions for its annual prizes in the following categories: Best Book (Marysa Navarro Best Book Prize), Best Article (Joseph T. Criscenti Best Article Prize), Best Dissertation, and Best Multimedia.

When should work be submitted?

Any time, but no later than **June 1, 2017**.

Who can submit?

- Authors working in or being trained at a NECLAS institution, i.e; institutions of higher education in New England (MA, VT, NH, MA, CT, RI, and Western NY); **OR**
- Authors currently living in the NECLAS area (New England: MA, VT, NH, MA, CT, RI, and Western NY); **AND**
- Authors who are **current members of NECLAS** (to renew membership or join NECLAS please visit www.neclas.org)

ALL AUTHORS MUST BE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING (2016-17 and/or 2017-18 membership) of NECLAS .

What work can be submitted? Work whose publication/conferral date is

2016 - Books: only monographs; edited volumes will not be accepted.

- Dissertations: defended at a NECLAS area institution (New England: MA, VT, NH, MA, CT, RI, and Western NY), or authored by individuals currently working at a NECLAS institution or living in the NECLAS area.
- Articles: in journals, or chapters in edited volumes.
- Translations of books or work related to Latin America.
- Multimedia: any media work containing audio, still images, animation, video, interactive content or expressions in the arts.

In the event of fewer than three submissions in a given prize category, they will automatically carry over for consideration the following year. Winners will be announced at the luncheon of the NECLAS Fall Meeting in November 2017, at the University of New Hampshire.

How many works and to how many prizes can I submit?

- Only one work.

How should work be submitted?

- **Electronic format** is strongly preferred for all categories. Electronic copies should be sent to the Committee Chair in the appropriate category and copied to NECLAS Secretariat. Please use the subject line "for consideration for NECLAS prize." The Chair will distribute to the other two members of the committee.

- **In the case of non-electronic submissions** of Books and Dissertations, please mail three copies to the NECLAS Secretariat along with a note indicating the NECLAS prize for which your work is to be considered. The Chair of each committee will distribute the submissions to the other two members of the committee.

- **The NECLAS Secretariat will accept three copies of work not provided in electronic form at El Instituto: Institute of Latina/o, Caribbean and Latin American Studies College of Liberal**
